

HB 103 - SB 56 Proposed Amendment

The Alabama Department of Public Health shall allow any patient/parent/guardian to opt out of the ImmPRINT vaccine registry program. Once an opt out request has been made by a patient/parent/guardian by presenting in person at a local Health Department and providing identification, the ImmPRINT registry will be cleared of all current and historical data pertaining to said individual or their minor child.

To protect the religious liberties of all Alabama citizens, religious exemptions to vaccinations issued by the ADPH shall not be entered into the IMMPRINT registry or any other tracking/data collection system.

All IMMPRINT users and affiliates have a duty in ensuring patient data in the system is safeguarded and secured.

All medical providers shall:

- Provide the patient/parent/guardian with the following information in writing via hard copy:
- Ensure that patients/parents/guardians are notified of the existence of ImmPRINT and the information contained in the ImmPRINT database,
- Inform patients/parents/guardians of the purpose and potential uses of ImmPRINT,
- Inform patients/parents/guardians of the types of organizations to which identifiable or unidentifiable information is commonly released,
- Inform patients/parents/guardians of the policies and procedures in place to protect patient privacy,
- Permit patients/parents/guardians to review and change information in ImmPRINT,
- Give patients/parents/guardians the right to request audits of all accesses to their electronic immunization record and to review such logs,
- Inform patients/parents/guardians of their right to refuse to have their immunization history and other identifiable information entered into ImmPRINT and of their right to change their decision at any time, and
- Document in the medical record a patient, parent or guardians decision not to participate in



ImmPRINT.

Failure to provide such written hard copy notification to the patient/parent/guardian of such information shall result in a fine of \$500.
